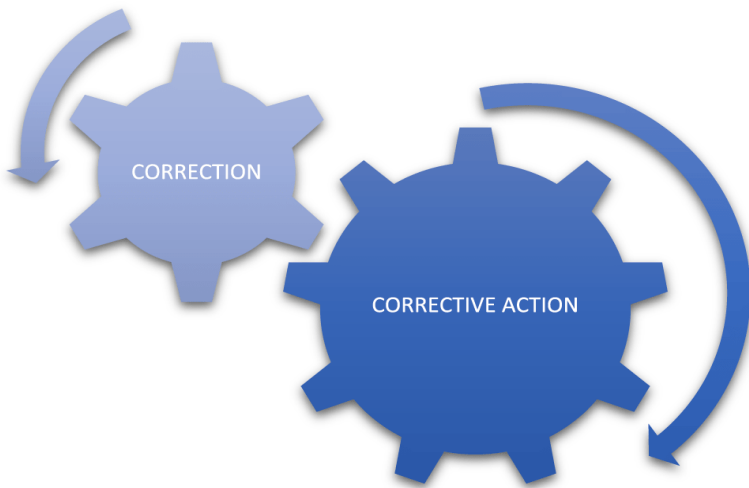

Highlights of Ongoing Projects

Medical Relief Activities



Organized a Free Health camp for under privilege people at the Luni, Tehsil- Mundra, and District- Kutch. Introduce to this Ceremony among villagers program was inaugurated by Our Doctor. They Guided all villagers to take part in this free health camp facility and said if we more cautious towards our health it will create better healthy society.

More than 160 Villagers from Mundra were given the free treatment and distributed free medicine at the Health camp during the day. The Health camp provided free tests for Health check-up, and offered counselling & treatment by trained Doctor and team.

The aim of the programme is to give comprehensives solutions to all quarries about their health while talking healthy foods and so on. Before the Health camp was set up, the volunteers put up banners and distributed leaflets in the surrounding areas, to create awareness about the camp which resulted in huge flock of people attending the camp and sharing their problems.

Teacher's day Celebration



We celebrate Teachers day in order to give honor and respect to our teachers. It is celebrated to highlight the role of teachers in making the future of the students.

A Virtual celebration conducted by our School by our students on 5th September 2020. The whole function was planned by our faculty & co – coordinators. We decided that, the responsibility of teaching is taken up by the students as an appreciation for their teachers. As per the culture, we always start our work with prayer. Our senior students took part positively on 5th September they took some lecture by their own interested subject and teach to junior student.



Science Exhibition

A Virtual Science Exhibition was held in our School, on the 30th of October, 2020 for classes 5th to 7th. It was a one-day affair which is held every alternate year. Students from all the classes starting from 6th were asked to participate.

Students of all four sections participated in the Exhibition. They were asked to choose their favourite topic and create something to explain it. They made still models, colourful charts, posters, working models, and so on.

The students also gave a beautiful and detailed explanation of their models to respected guest. They were even questioned about the scientific concepts and theories behind their project. Various sustainable topics and ideas were picked up and demonstrated by visual. For Practical Knowledge of Science models our teacher have guided the students in science lab.

Rabbani Education & Charitable Trust helps women to empower and employ them. Till now we have trained more than 250 women and helped them in employment. In Mundra, Kutch most of the women are illiterate and unemployed. Their financial condition is bad as the number of individuals earning is very minimal, most of the girls and

women are dependent on others for their daily expenses. We have trained some women with sewing skills and help them to grow in the market.

This initiative helps marginalized and deprived Women by providing them skill development training on tailoring, handicraft, bag making, weaving, knotting etc. so that the problem of unemployment will end and poor women of the deprived community will get a sustainable livelihood and hence become independent.

Benefits of this initiative

- Women will get training on stitching.
- The training will be for 3 months.
- After completion of their training we will also provide them employment.

The training curriculum focus will be on the following: -

1. Designing
2. Measurement & Cutting
3. Stitching
4. Pressing
5. Digital Sublimation Printing
6. Product Packing
7. Thread cleaning

New Project of Fighting Towards COVID -19



Our Institute extended support to the marginalized, by assuring that the healthcare workers stand at the first line of defence. These activities involved distribution of ration kits, cooked meals, PPE, Nourishment supplement, bedding kits etc.

contracting Covid-19, with possibly grave consequences. For them, every day has been a struggle due to income instability, lack of access to preventative measures and working to screen and treat affected people.

Experts agree that the best way of dealing with this crisis is through preventative measures, like social distancing, quarantining probable cases and following good personal hygiene. Clean and Green Village Program



In order to accelerate the pace of achievements under Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in rural areas of the district, several programmes on "Clean and Green Villages" were conducted under Iconic Week Celebrations, as part of Gram Swaraj Month in all the Panchayat Blocks of Mundra. The programmes were held on the directions of the Deputy Commissioner Mundra, under ongoing Gram Swaraj month in Mundra and Blocks of the District as a universal call to action to end poverty, protect the planet, and ensure that by 2030 all people enjoy peace and prosperity.

The activities ranged from cleaning of Water Bodies, Cleaning drives, awareness about discontinuing use of Single Use Plastics to Plantation.

During the programmes, the public representatives along with local public ensured that the message of Clean and Green villages will be carried forward to all other residents so that cleanliness is ensured through community led initiatives like these in future as well.

Animal Welfare Activities



Good animal welfare requires disease prevention and veterinary treatment, appropriate shelter, management, nutrition, humane handling, transport and eventually, humane slaughter. Animal welfare refers to an animal's physical and mental state, and how it is coping with its situation. According to the World Organization for Animal Health (Office International des Epizooties 2013) an animal is in a good state of welfare if it is healthy, comfortable, well nourished, safe, able to express its innate behaviour, and is not suffering from negative states such as pain, fear and distress. Rabbani Education & Charitable Trust always encourages animal welfare activities. For this Purpose we have Distribute Fodder in different cow shelter for welfare of such animals.

Connecting to last mile



Our volunteers at Rabbani Education & Charitable are eyeing blanket and old clothes distribution in different regions of Mundra, Kutch .The pleasure in fulfilling the basic requirement of people carries a different feeling that can't be explained in words. Homeless people mostly reside in slum areas by constructing shacks and wooden houses with available materials. They don't have clothes to cover their body, and they spend their winter without a blanket. And that's the reason behind the death of thousands of people every year in the winter season. Whenever we visit such places with our volunteers, we get a question in our mind that isn't our responsibility to assist such poor and needy people in living a life full of hope and opportunities? In each shack, we come across several people and give them blankets along with clothes. Through our blanket distribution activities this year, many poverty-stricken families have received the benefits that would eventually help them in surviving amid the cold and chilling winter.

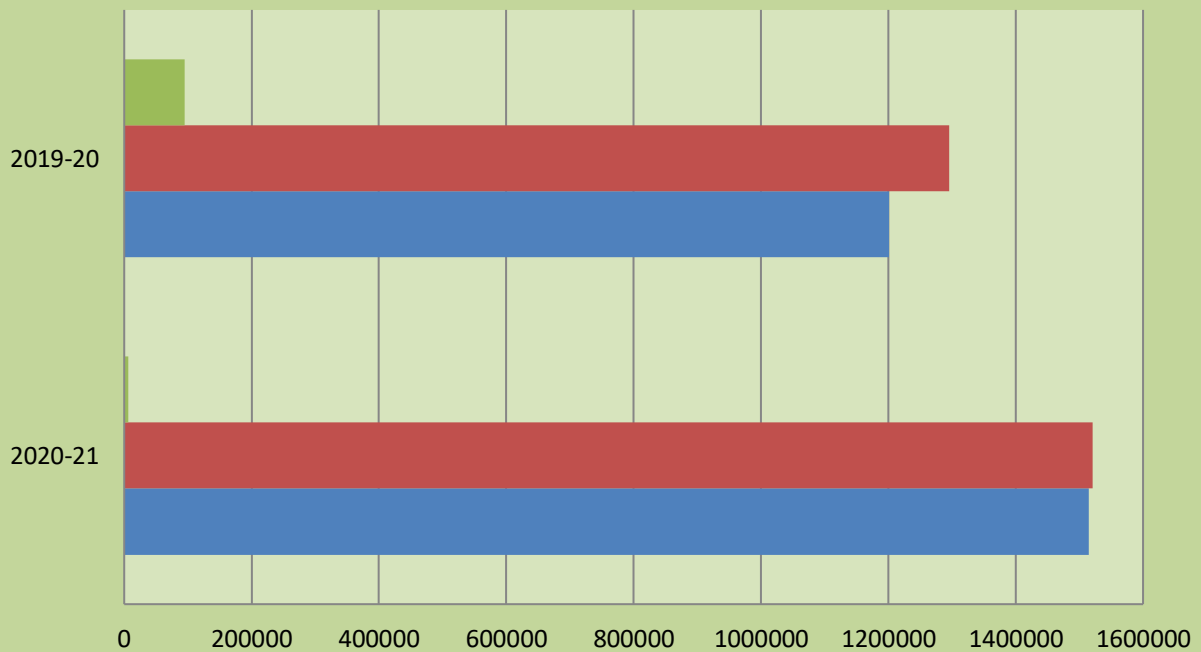
