The vision of Rabbani Education and Charitable Trust is to established a people led trust where no remains hungry, unemployed, uneducated and exploited.

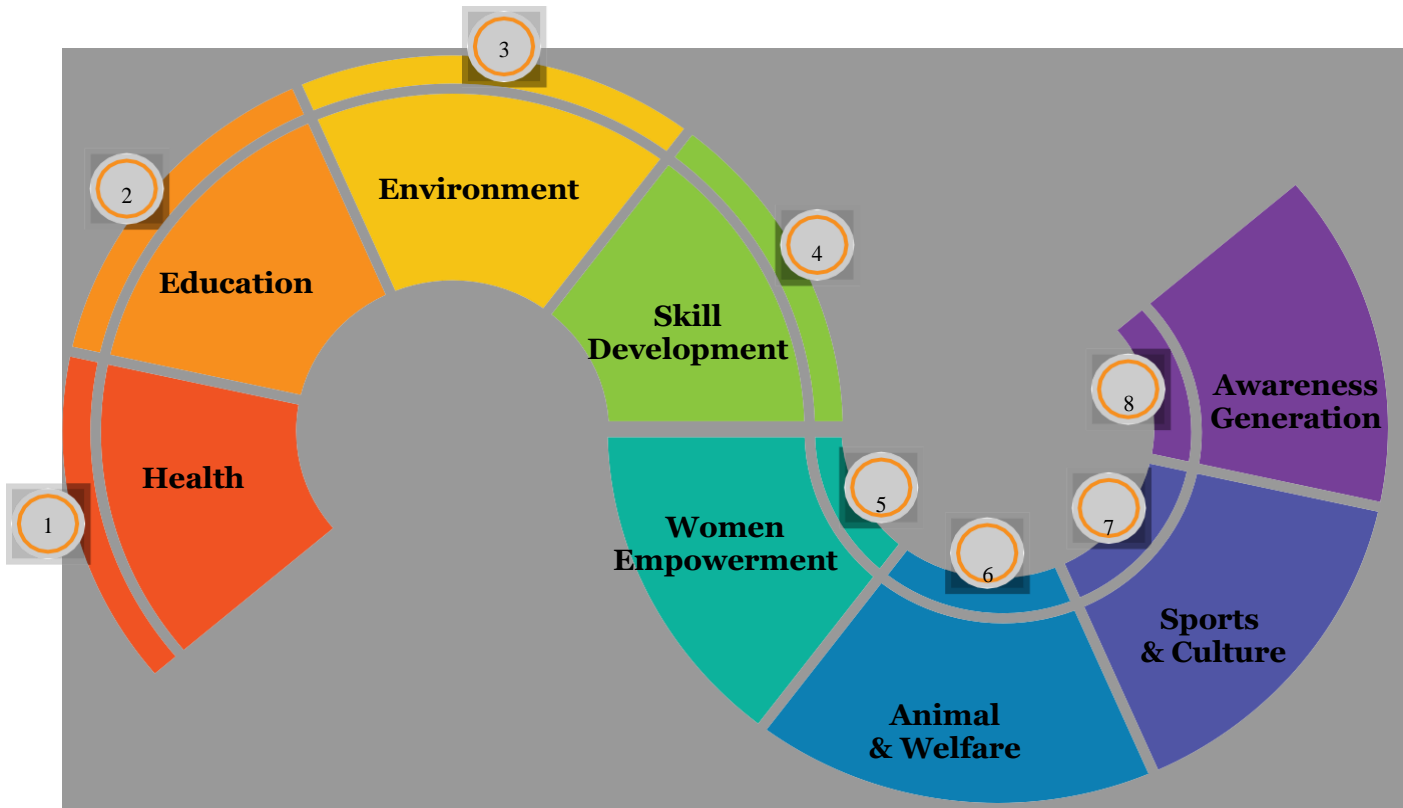

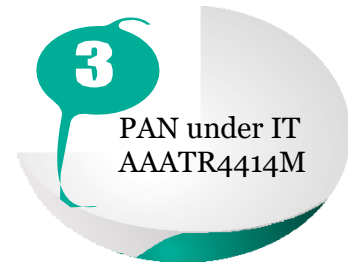

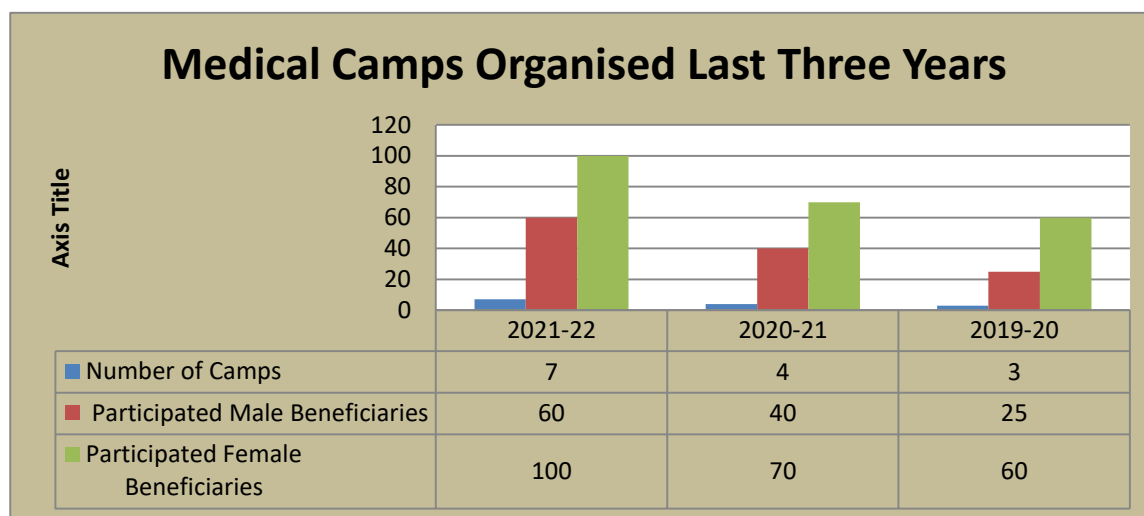

Highlights of Ongoing Project from Last Three Years

Medical Relief activities

We have Organised Medical Check up Camps on various location of Mundra Kutch. We have run this project since last three years to provide free medicine to underprivileged people



Activities undertaken in our School



Along with imparting technical and professional education to the students, schools are also responsible for the mental and physical development of the students. It is the duty of a school to impart moral values, ethics, etiquettes, discipline, confidence, and other personality traits to the students. For this, the school conducts many different activities like morning assemblies, sessions on moral education, personality development sessions and an array of extra-curricular activities. Every activity holds its own significance in the development of students. For These purpose we have promoted various extracurricular & Cultural activities in our school. In Present 135 students enrolled in our school. Our government introduced the Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao (BBBP) scheme to address concerns of gender discrimination and women empowerment in the country. The name Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao translates to '**Save the girl child, educate the girl child**'. We have also initiate to support girls education, In next year we have also plan for 02 girls schools in Mundra Block & Wankaner Block each.



Baseline Survey of Livelihood of Local Women



Born and Brought up in the area and within the Local Women community, with its vast experience team in rural marketing, working with the poor, appropriate technology innovations, particularly in livelihood & Enterprise Development with rural community especially women of underprivileged family, decided to make attempts to develop appropriate systems for Value Addition of the local Value chain of suitable enterprise opportunities and possible market linkages for providing higher returns to the deserving families of the area.

In year 2021 we have conducted survey for Women community in Mundra district's various locations. Feedback from community we have decided to continue this activity in this year also & we have conducted a quick assessment on the livelihood pattern at Mundra are largely depended on handicraft activities.

A mapping was attempted to explore and develop a management system for linking Local communities to markets through Value Addition in the Value chain of Handicraft market of this area.

“Women communities to bring about positive qualitative and quantitative changes in their existing strategies resulting in significant and sustainable reduction in their vulnerability through improvements in livelihoods. The development objective of the project is to promote livelihood security of the poor communities. The Two immediate objectives of the project are to:

- Assist the communities to empower themselves to collectively address their problems and needs;
- Introduce various economic and community welfare activities which are operated and managed by their community organizations.

Training Program to Improve Handicraft Skill for Local Women Artisans



Capacity building and trainings are essential forms of intervention to help communities identify activities that can enhance their livelihood options. Indigenous women from the Mundra communities of the Kutch district in Gujarat were engaged in a similar workshop/training that was held over two days.

The focus of the workshop was to promote leadership development and capacity building of Mundra Block women. The Mundra communities of Kutch District have traditionally been dependent on Hand Embroidery and natural resources both for subsistence and their livelihoods. However, with changes in the

markets, they are not getting a good value for a variety of traditional products that they manufactured and sold, like a variety of Embroidery products sold in local markets.

In this context, the women were provided training in handicraft making using locally available material, which would help boost income generation.



Other Development Projects

Tree Plantation Program



Trees are vital to the environment. They provide us with fresh air to breathe, a shelter for birds and animals. They also provide us with wood for various purposes, along with many medicinal and spiritual properties. However, deforestation has been its main enemy. This problem needs to be curtailed to ensure that the ecological balance is maintained. Tree plantation is the process of planting seedlings into the ground. This process is in a planned manner. Tree plantation depends upon the geography and the topology of the region. Usually, planting trees that grow quickly are preferred. Many trees are indigenous and are encouraged by many to be grown to maintain natural heritage. Tree plantation refers to planting seedlings in the soil. It is done during the monsoon season, from July to September in India. Seedlings are planted in the Earth, and the types grown are based on soil and climate of the region. Rabbani Education & Charitable Trust Planted an approx 1200 Sapling Trees.

Clean & Green Village Program

The Green village initiative focuses on activities like tree plantation, organic farming, conservation of village ecosystems & biodiversity, promotion of new and renewable energy sources including eco-friendly innovations.

A hungry stomach is always a soul standing in the well of pain and loss. People spending their life on the streets and footpaths have become a common sight in recent times. Impoverished people who can't manage the budget to buy a roof over their head struggle to survive on the footpaths and flyovers of well-built metro stations in different areas of Mundra.

Our volunteers at Rabbani Education & Charitable Trust are eyeing blanket and New clothes distribution in different regions of Mundra, and other places too. The pleasure in fulfilling the basic requirement of people carries a different feeling that can't be explained in words. Homeless people mostly reside in slum areas by constructing shacks and wooden houses with available materials. They don't have clothes to cover their body, and they spend their winter without a blanket. And that's the reason behind the death of thousands of people every year in the winter season. Whenever we visit such places with our volunteers, we get a question in our mind that isn't our responsibility to assist such poor and needy people in living a life full of hope and opportunities? In n each shack, we come across several people and give them blankets along with clothes. Also, we distribute blankets to abandoned people living a hopeless life, and we are endeavoring to bring some shadows of hope in their lives

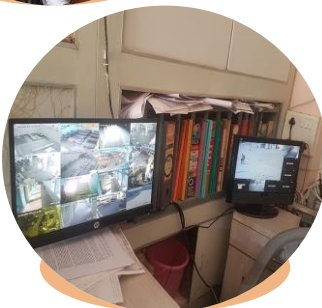


Sports Activities

Female literacy is very low in rural villages like Rasikgadh Village of Wankaner Block of Morbi District, Gujarat and Village Sadau of Mundra Block of Kutch District Gujarat. Girls & Boys are kept away from formal schooling and they are married by arrangement in their teenage years. This has some serious consequences such as, poor health and loss of equal opportunities, to individuals, families, communities and to the country. The parents are less aware about the benefits of educating girls and rural boys. Our Plan to establishment of two schools. 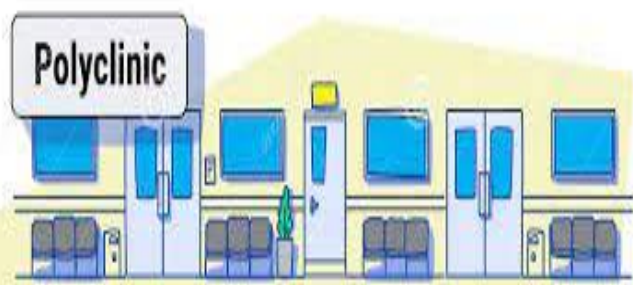

Health is not the mere absence of disease; it is a requisite for defining a person's overall well being. Healthcare needs of individuals living in rural areas are different from those in urban areas, and rural areas often suffer from a lack of access to healthcare. These differences are the result of geographic,

demographic, socioeconomic, workplace, and personal health factors. For example, many rural communities have a large proportion of elderly people and children. With relatively few people of working age (20–50 years of age), such communities have a high dependency ratio. People living in rural areas also tend to have poorer socioeconomic conditions, less education, higher rates of tobacco and alcohol use, and higher mortality rates when compared to their urban counterparts. There are also high rates of poverty among rural dwellers in many parts of the KUTCH, and poverty is one of the biggest social determinants of health. Health related Infrastructural facilities are very poor in Mundra Block Specially in Luni Village. To cater this problem we will plan about establishment of one Poly Clinic in Luni village of Mundra Block of Kutch District

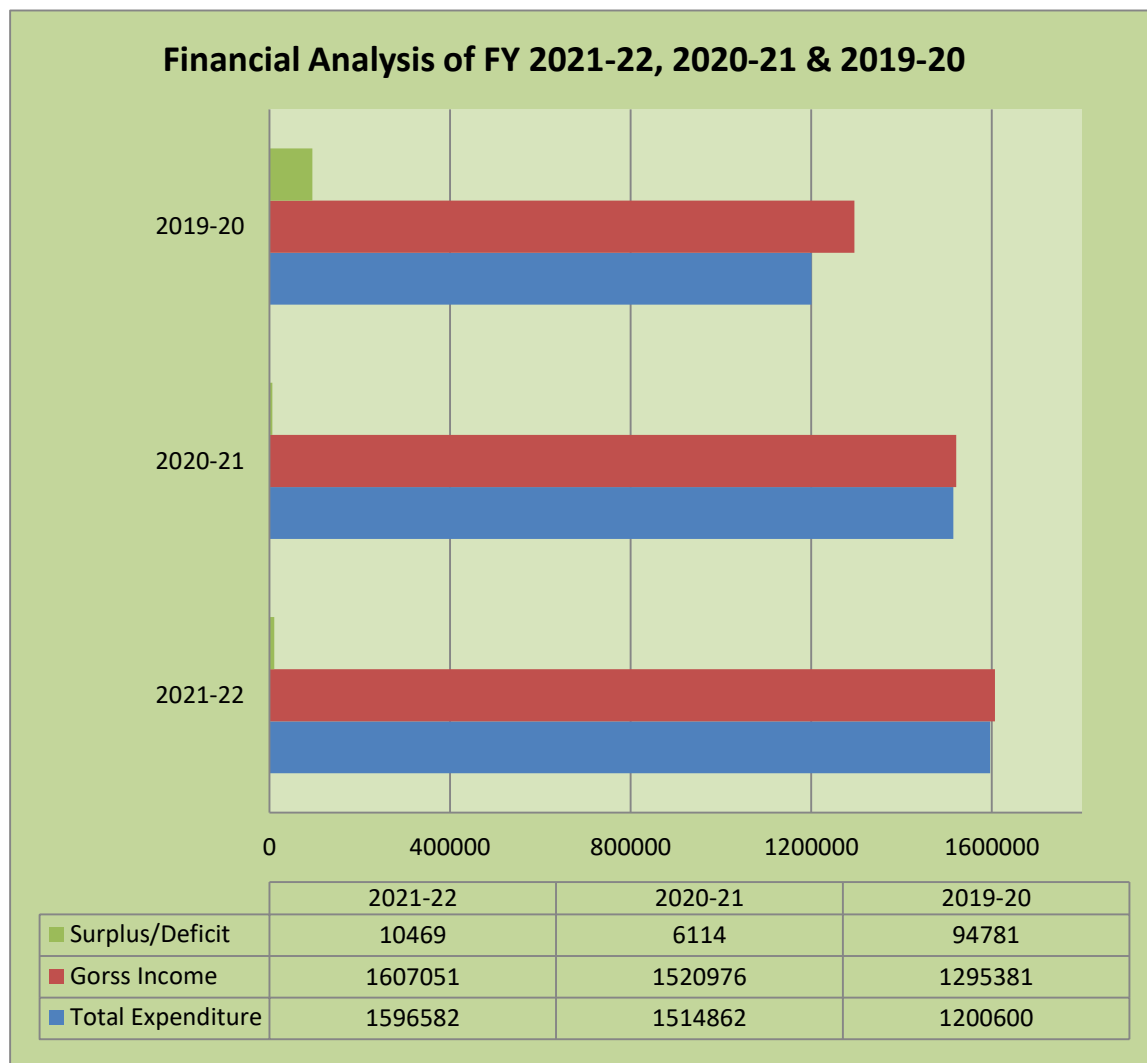
